**Second Sunday of Lent Reflection:** Today, God asks Abraham to bring his only son, Isaac, to the altar for sacrifice. Imagine placing so much trust in the Lord that you would be willing to sacrifice your own child. Abraham had no way of knowing what the Lord had planned or why the Lord was requiring him to sacrifice Isaac, yet he trusted in the Lord and prepared to give an ultimate sacrifice. Often, the Lord calls us as He called Abraham. He asks us to bear suffering and hardships without knowing the fullness of His plan. People who suffer grave illnesses have opportunities to follow in the footsteps of trust that the Lord will reveal His greater plan and will provide for all their needs, as He did for Abraham. As caregivers, the Lord entrusts us with the task of helping provide for the needs of the sick. Those battling with cancer trust that the Lord will provide, and often, He provides us to help.
