**St. Luke Cemetery Prices:** Due to increased burial costs, the prices at St. Luke Cemetery have increased. The price of a gravesite is now \$400 and the burial fee is \$600. Besides the need to cover the higher burial expense, we must generate enough funds to pay for the upkeep of the cemetery. We have an annual collection for the cemetery in October, which does not come close to covering the costs of maintenance. The gravesites of our loved ones buried at St. Luke Cemetery require perpetual care. St. Luke Cemetery accounts are separate from the parish operating accounts.

We will send it to the Diocese of Columbus. If you are currently a member of another parish in the diocese, they will transfer your membership to St. Luke's.
