A Stewardship Moment: Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Weekend of June 4/5, 2016

Saint Paul begins today's second reading by stating that he was "called" to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ. As baptized Catholics who have an opportunity to share in Christ's life through the Eucharist regularly, we too are called to proclaim the teachings of Christ. We are stewards of Christ's Gospel. But how are we responding to that call? Do we listen for the guidance of the Holy Spirit? Do we evade, dodge or ignore the Lord's call? Do we attempt to proclaim the Gospel in a spirit of compassion and love? Reflect on how you exercise stewardship over the Gospel.

The Bishop's Annual Appeal continues. We have received Pledges of \$36,380 so far. We are over the goal but about half our parishioners have not made a pledge. Young Adults: At age 23 you MUST register under your own name! Being a registered member makes it easier to be married, to have an infant baptized, even for a funeral. If you are asked to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation, the parish will be asked to provide confirmation of membership at the Parish and we need to see that you are a registered, active, contributing member of St. Luke's.

To register at St. Luke Parish, please pick up a Family Registration form in the church from the table near the side entrance or in the vestibule, stop at the office, or one can be mailed to you upon request. Just fill it out with your information and return it to the parish office. We will send it to the Diocese of Columbus. If you are currently a member of another parish in the diocese, the diocese will transfer your membership to St. Luke's. (You cannot be a member of two parishes at once.)
