**The Feast of Corpus Christi Procession** begins next Sunday, June 18 at St. Vincent de Paul Church immediately following the 11:30am Mass. You should be at the church no later than 12:20pm to join the procession. This year's route is 1.2 miles long and goes east from the church to South Park Street to East Vine Street and will return westbound on High Street to the church. There will be four prayer stations located at Parishioner's homes to stop and pray. This represents our bringing Christ to the four corners of the Earth. Jesus truly present in the Eucharist, known as the Blessed Sacrament, is placed in a monstrance and is held aloft by a member of the clergy during the procession. After the procession, parishioners return to the church, where benediction (thanksgiving) concludes the service.
