Special Collection for Sanctuary Community Action's Hot Meal program, September 2nd & 3rd

Sanctuary Community Action is a non-profit agency located at 304 Market St, Danville, serving all residents in East Knox and Danville School districts. *The mission of Sanctuary Community Action (SCA) is to improve the quality of life of the people in the Eastern Knox County area by providing and coordinating health, education and social services.* In addition to opening our facility to Knox County Health Dept for WIC & immunizations; Family Life Counseling services; Dr. Elder's office of primary care; and Rebecca Metcalf, CNP, we also provide a home cooked hot meal at noon time 5 days a week to seniors who are homebound due to illness, injury or inability to prepare their meal. Meals are prepared in the licensed kitchen of Danville United Methodist church and delivered by caring and dedicated community members--many from St. Luke. The proceeds from this collection will be directed entirely to the hot meal program. We receive the majority of funding for the meal program through the county-wide senior services levy but there has been a reduction in funding for the current levy year (April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018) and your contribution will help to cover the reduction in funds. SCA has two other programs for seniors—homemaking and lawn mowing—but the hot meal program has priority and if senior programs face a reduction, it will be necessary to reduce or cut the homemaking and lawn mowing to protect the meal program.
